other members of the team at Energy Distribution Partners. So, when they crossed paths during the NPGA's 2022 Southeast Expo, it spurred a conversation that ultimately led to the decision to sell Barrett Propane to EDP.

According to Dave, "We had just started the process of exploring companies that might be the right fit for Barrett Propane, so the timing was right for us to connect with the EDP team.

"One big factor that impacted our decision to choose EDP was their commitment to remain active in the local community," said Dave. "Not only did EDP commit to taking good care of our customers and employees, they agreed to retain our company name and remain active on a local level. Fast forward to August 9th, 2022: Just four months later, Barrett Propane joined the EDP family of companies. Dave commented, "There was a real trust factor and mutual respect with the EDP

Dave said he and his family have been pleased with their decision. The process was quick and there were no bumps along the way.
